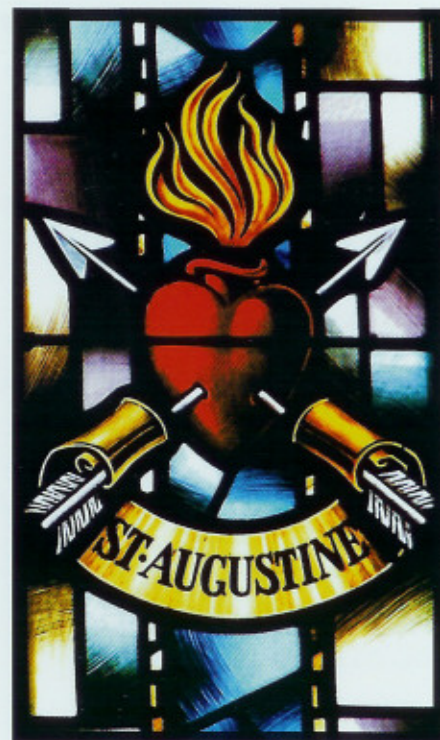

## OUR BEGINNING

This faith sharing and support group was born out of a response to needs and issues raised by men and women from across the Diocese of Metuchen during its Synod, which concluded in 2007.

“The Department of Pastoral Life, in collaboration with the Office of Communication and Public Relations, is to help raise awareness about existing support groups for men and women with same sex attraction and their families ...” ( SYNOD - SOCIAL JUSTICE, §45 )

We take as a guide the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' 1997 pastoral, ***Always Our Children: A Pastoral Message to Parents of Homosexual Children and Suggestions for Pastoral Ministers.***

“All in all, it is essential to recall one basic truth. God loves every person as a unique individual. Sexual identity helps to define the unique persons we are. One component of our sexual identity is sexual orientation. Thus, our total personhood is more encompassing than sexual orientation.
