



Home School Program **Church of the Sacred Heart Religious Education**

The Home School Program option is an opportunity for families with special needs or concerns to instruct their child at home under the supervision of the Director of Religious Education. The parents agree to commit to setting aside time for home schooling their child/children in religious education and to make every effort to complete the grade level work in the timeframe allowed.

An extension of time to complete this work may be granted with understanding that the child/children cannot go onto the next grade level until the grade level work and testing has been completed by the child/children and approved by the Director of Religious Education.

The parents agree to bring their child/children in for the standardized testing provided by the program textbook company on the scheduled testing dates. Special consideration will be granted should the child require a different test modality or have difficulty completing the work. In some cases, a child may need to repeat the course work before given the opportunity for a re-test.

Parents are asked to sign a contract to indicate that they understand that home schooling education is to be taken seriously and done diligently. Parents indicate by their signature that they accept responsibility for enabling their child/children to successfully complete the testing and move into the next grade level. The contract is valid for one year only. A new registration form must be completed and sent to the Religious Education Office each year that the family chooses to participate in the regularly scheduled Religious Education Program classes or in the Home School Program.
